

2015-2016 Preferred Class Attire

- A neat and tidy appearance sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students, teacher, and the art of dance.
- Teachers must be able to see the dancer's body outline clearly in order to make proper corrections on posture, alignment, etc.
- Hair must be properly secured and tied up off of the face and neck for all styles of dance.
- Jewelry must not be loose or dangling.
- Gum chewing is not allowed due to danger of choking and appearance.
- No loose fitting pants, blue jeans or t-shirts (they are not dance attire).
- No costumes are allowed in class unless a dress up day is announced by the individual teacher.

Preschool Dancers	Any color and style of leotard. Attached skirts or tutus are optional. Pink tights
Combo Dance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teen Jazz (ages 13 – 18) • Lyrical (all ages) 	Leotard & tights (any color, any style) <i>Skirts and shorts may be worn over top of the leotard, but tights must still be worn underneath.</i>
Ages 5+ <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jazz Hip Hop • Tap Musical Theater 	Leotard & tights (any color, any style) or jazz pants and t-shirt <i>Skirts and shorts may be worn over top of the leotard, but tights must still be worn underneath.</i>
Acro (ages 6 – 18)	Leotard & tights, (any color, any style) <i>Skirts and shorts may be worn over top of the leotard, but tights must still be worn underneath. Jazz pants and leotard (no Ts); Shortitard or unitards</i>
Ballet I-V (ages 7 -18)	Black leotard (any style) & pink tights. Skirts at the discretion of the instructor.
Boys (all ages)	Musical Theater and Acro: basketball shorts, jazz pants or sweats and Ts (tucked in). Tap, Jazz – Jazz pants & Ts, Black jazz shoes & black tap shoes Ballet – Black jazz pants, white fitted Ts, and black ballet shoes

DANCE SHOES are required for all dance and theater classes!

- Preschool Dancers: Pink leather ballet flats. Tan Mary-Jane taps for Preschool II and Petite Feet
- Tap and Jazz Combo/beg: Tan Mary Jane tap shoes and tan full sole jazz shoes
- Tap and Jazz Combo/int: Tan slip-on tap shoes and tan full sole jazz shoes
- Jr. and Teen Tap and Jazz: Capezio or Bloch tie-ups (split sole) and tan split sole jazz shoes
- Advanced Tap: Tan split sole tie-ups
- Advanced Jazz: Black and tan jazz shoes or pedant's (see instructor for details)
- Guys Tap: Black slip-on leather tap shoes
- Guys Jazz: Black slip-on leather jazz shoes
- Ballet Level I and II: Pink full sole flats
- Level III: Pink split sole ballet flats
- Musical Theater Ladies: Tan slip-on (or tie for narrow feet)
- Musical Theater Guys: Black leather jazz shoes
- Hip Hop for all: Ultra Arch Dance Sneakers by Revolution in gray.
- Lyrical: Dance Paws or Half Sole
